### 5<sup>th</sup> Grade:

- A \$2 math fee will be collected from each student on the first day of school.
- Most supplies will be turned in to the homeroom teacher so that students will not have to keep up with them during the school year.
- Send all supplies on the first day.
- Label student's first and last name on all pencils, pens, sharpener, and scissors with a permanent marker.
  
- 1-inch, 3-ring blue binder with clear pockets on the front and back for math
- 3 red ink-pens
- Package of 12 black ink-pens (label)
- 48 #2 sharpened pencils (label)
- 3 Pink Pearl erasers
- 1 box of 10 or 12 Crayola Classic Color markers
- 1 box of 24 Crayola colored pencils
- 6 glue sticks
- 1 small plastic pencil sharpener (that holds shavings) - label
- 300 sheets wide-ruled notebook paper
- Package of sheet protectors
- Green spiral (70 or more sheets) for science
- Blue spiral (70 or more sheets) for math
- Red spiral (70 or more sheets) for reading
- Purple spiral (70 or more sheets) for English
- Green, plastic, 3-prong folder for science
- Yellow, plastic, 3-prong folder for social studies
- 2 red pocket folders without prongs
- Pointed, metal scissors (label)
- 3-ring, zippered binder (sometimes called a Trapper Keeper) - label
- Package of 8 notebook dividers
- 3 thin Hi-Lighters
- 3 large (200 count) boxes of tissue
